[Rekha DR] Hello, everybody. Are you an enterprise automation expert or a business process owner working on enterprise automation? Here is the fantastic news. You can now import business process model and notation BPMN files into SAP Build Process Automation and convert them into executable business processes. SAP delivers enterprise automation with SAP Signavio and SAP Build Process Automation solutions. Using SAP Signavio Process Manager, you can model your business process and export the BPMN file. You could also use NetViewer BPM tool or any tool for that matter that supports process model creation and export as BPMN. Then import this file into SAP Build Process Automation to generate process extensions and automations. This follows a model to execute pattern and helps you migrate the processes easily to SAP Build Process Automation. If you want to understand how to carry out this task with a step-by-step guide with a business use case example, then do read through this excellent blog post by our enterprise automation expert, Rama Muradi.
