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Transcript

David Chaviano: Hello, everybody, and welcome to another episode of SAP Learning Insights. It's a short one today. I just want to do a quick introduction to a miniseries that's going to be added to the podcast, Intern View. And to introduce Intern View to the audience, we have Svenja on board. David Chaviano: That sounds excellent. And it's great to hear from the interns, from the beginners. They're not yet institutionalized, so they're going to be able to speak.

Svenja Römer: They're brutally honest!
